Categories 2-DIMENSIONAL / 3-DIMENSIONAL WORKS

- Oil, Acrylic
- Watercolor, Tempura, Gouache, etc.
- Drawing (Pencil, Pastel, Charcoal, Pen & Ink, etc.)
- Mixed Media
- Photography (must be one of a limited edition)
- 3-Dimensional

Eligibility and Limitations

Open to all residents of Georgia age 18 and older. Work must be original and created by the artist within the last 2 years. Works must not have been exhibited at an AGNWG competition previously. Work completed under the direction of an instructor or in a class is not acceptable. Gicleés will not be accepted.

Two dimensional work must be ready to hang with wire. Saw tooth hangers are not acceptable. Works cannot be greater than 40" in width including the frame. No exceptions. Gallery

wrapped works need not be framed but must have the sides painted.

Three dimensional works must not exceed 45 lbs or 60" in any direction. 3-D work must be hand delivered and picked up by the artist.

AGNWG retains the right to refuse acceptance of works it deems inappropriate due to content, weight, size or quality of work.

Liability

AGNWG and the Mable House Art Center will demonstrate reasonable care in handling the artwork. However, neither AGNWG, South Cobb Arts Alliance nor Mable House will take responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged works. Artists are encouraged to secure their own private insurance coverage.

Entry Fees

Entrants may submit up to 3 works for consideration. Non member entry fees are \$35 for up to three entries. AGNWG members: \$25 for up to three entries. All fees are non-refundable.

Images

Images must be submitted on a CD along with the application and a check or money order made payable to AGNWG. Images must include artist name, category, title, medium and corresponding entry number from the application form.

Images must be in RGB/jpeg format. Minimum file size: 500kb. Maximum file size: 5MB. Resolution: 150 dpi. Longest dimension: 900 pixels.

If you wish your CD returned, please include a self addressed CD mailer with appropriate postage in with your application.

Additional Information

A 6 % sales tax will be collected on all sales. A 25% commission on all sales will be donated to the South Cobb Arts Alliance.

Juror

Professor Joe Remillard earned his MFA from UGA and accepted a full time teaching position with K.S.U. in the Arts Dept. He has traveled abroad extensively and exhibited nationally. He is represented by multiple galleries including Mason-Muir in Atlanta and has had work acquired by the Morris Museum. Professor Remillard's works have been featured in national magazines such as American Artist, International Artist and The Artist Magazine. His work is described as traditional realism. One of his quotes says it best, "life is incredibly precious and fleeting and through my art, I can freeze life in it's tracks."
